Online Training Course on Sufficiency Economy Philosophy (SEP) in Community-based and Economic Development (CBED) 2022

1. Course Title Online Sufficiency Economy Philosophy (SEP) in Community-based Development (CBD), International Training Course 2022

2. Duration 2 weeks (during 23 May - 3 June, 2022)

3. Background and Rational The international training course on SEP in community development has been an annual 5 weeks training program organized by joint efforts of TICA and Kasetsart University for the last decade.

Recently, there has been a shift in economic development paradigms from growth-based to community-based development as a mechanism to achieve sustainable development. Experiences have shown that community-based development helps empower communities and strengthening the capabilities of local citizens to undertake self-initiated development activities in response to their needs.

The SEP stressed the middle path as an overriding principle for appropriate conduct by the populace at all levels. "Sufficiency" means moderation, reasonableness, and the need of self-immunity for enough protection from impact arising from internal and external changes. To achieve this, an application of knowledge with consideration and prudence is essential. At the same time, it is crucial to strengthen the moral fiber of the nation so that everyone adheres to the principles of honesty and integrity.

The training course "Sufficiency Economy Philosophy in Community-based Development" provides knowledge of SEP linking to economic concepts/theories and community-based development. During the training course, number of case studies will be illustrated to explain what SEP means in practices. In addition, the training course will provide the techniques/tools (project identification, logical framework, and financial economic and risk analysis) examples for development project following SEP.

4. Objectives The training course is designed to: 1 provide participants with knowledge and understanding of Sufficiency Economy Philosophy (SEP) and related economic theories and concepts

2. explain participants the applications of SEP (individuals, SMEs, communities, organizations, and macro policy implication)

3. provide participants with multiple case studies following SEP

4. demonstrate participants with techniques/tools required for development project formulation, monitoring and evaluation of projects following SEP
